




SUPPLEMENTAL \ BID BULLETIN NO.1

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is issued to modify, amend or clarify items in the Bidding Documents for the project: Supply and Delivery of Spare Parts for Airfield Ground Lighting System. This shall form an integral part of the bidding documents for the above-mentioned project.

The following were the queries raised by the prospective bidders during the Pre-Bid Conference held on 31 March 2017 at the CIAC Board Room, as well as the corresponding remarks or instructions made by the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) members and Office of Prime Responsibility (OPR):

Item	Queries\Clarifications	Remarks/Instructions
1.	Request raised by Malcolm Ong of Evercon Builders and Equipment Corporation: I have a question regarding item 6.1 Constant Current Regulator (CCR) of the Bill of Quantities (BOQ) Form attached to the bidding documents. Since this is a stand alone system the MCR3 is a model of a particular brand. May we request that type MCR3 be deleted?	The MCR3 referred in the Bill of Quantities (BOQ) means Microprocessor Controlled Regulator (MCR). The MCR3 shall be amended to MCR meaning Microprocessor Controlled Regulator.
2.	Query raised by Malcolm Ong of Evercon Builders and Equipment Corporation: Regarding the Holding Position Light indicated in item 11 of the Bill of Quantities (BOQ). It is stated ten (10) sets in the BOQ while in the Schedule of Requirements it is stated only one (1) lot. Which is correct?	The correct requirement for the Holding Position Light is one (1) set. Please see attached revised Bill of Quantities (BOQ) indicating the corrections and the breakdown of other items.
3.	Query raised by Malcolm Ong of Evercon Builders and Equipment Corporation: Regarding the Taxiway Edge Lightings/Elevated (ADB Model VEE-3-030) indicated on item 5.1 of the Bill of Quantities (BOQ), it is stated 360 degrees blue prismatic dome type S sealed in the upper body for RVE-S and RPL-S. Is this the same as the ADB Model VEE-3-030?	The requirement for "360 deg. blue prismatic dome type S sealed in the upper body for RVE-S and RPL-S is similar to ADB Model VEE-3-030."
4.	Query raised by Malcolm Ong of Evercon Builders and Equipment Corporation:	



	Regarding Taxiway Guidance Signages indicated on item 7 of the Bill of Quantities (BOQ), are these Safegate signs?	The existing taxiway guidance signage is ATG airport and not Safegate. Please see attached revised Bill of Quantities (BOQ) indicating the corrections and the breakdown of other items.
5.	<p>Query raised by Louie Lucban of Stealth Ventures Corporation:</p> <p>Our question is on the five (5) years requirement for the completed similar contract from the date of submission and receipt of bids, the GPPB issued a Resolution 16-2014 where it is stated that the period for completed similar contract shall no longer be required.</p> <p>Mr. Malcolm Ong commented that the resolution issued pertained only to infrastructure projects, since this is a procurement of goods; I believe BAC can recommend the five (5)-year period.</p>	Since this project is categorized as procurement of goods, the requirement that bidders should have completed, within five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the project shall be retained.
6.	<p>Request raised by Louie Lucban of Stealth Ventures Corporation:</p> <p>Regarding the required delivery period of sixty (60) calendar days, may we request that this be adjusted to three months or three months and a half (90 to 105 calendar days).</p> <p>There are three different products for different brands, ADB, Thorn and Safegate. We may not be able to supply all because we might not be allowed to buy the competitors' brand and include it in our bid. Recently, ADB was granted permission to carry out brands, I think there is a regulation that one manufacturer cannot.</p>	<p>No. The delivery period of sixty (60) calendar days from the receipt of the Notice to Proceed shall be retained.</p> <p>Note: Samples of the spare parts should be made available during post qualification (EMD).</p>
8.	<p>Query raised by Malcolm Ong of Evercon Builders and Equipment Corporation:</p> <p>Regarding the Constant Current Regulator and Rotating Beacon Light, is this supply only?</p>	The installation is included.
9.	<p>Query raised by Malcolm Ong of Evercon Builders and Equipment Corporation:</p> <p>What may be considered as similar projects?</p>	Supply and Delivery of spare parts for AGLS.
10.	<p>Query raised by Louie Lucban of Stealth Ventures Corporation:</p> <p>May we know the deadline for the submission of additional queries and /or requests for</p>	The deadline for the submission of additional queries and /or

	clarifications?	requests for clarifications in writing is on April 3, 2017 (Monday) not later than 5:00 p.m.
11.	<p>Query raised by Malcolm Ong of Evercon Builders and Equipment Corporation:</p> <p>Since the Submission and Opening of Bids is scheduled on a holy week, what if April 12, 2017 shall be declared half day?</p>	The BAC will still conduct the Submission and Opening of Bids on April 12, 2017 even if this will be declared holiday or half day.

II. Additional reminders and clarifications to all prospective proponents:

1. The bidding process involves non-discretionary pass/fail criteria, whereby, if a Bidder submits the required document, it shall be rated "passed" for that particular requirement. In this regard, bids that fail to include any requirement or are incomplete or patently insufficient shall be considered or rated "failed".
2. The original and copies of the bids shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed each pages by the bidder or its duly authorized representative/s.
3. The deadline for the Submission of Bids is on **April 12, 2017 (Wednesday)**, no later than **2:45 PM** Philippine Standard Time (PST) at the Meeting Room D, Royce Hotel and Casino, Manuel Roxas St., Corner N. Aquino Avenue, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga Late bids shall not be accepted.
4. The Opening of Bids shall be conducted on the same day at **3:00 PM**, Meeting Room D, Royce Hotel and Casino, Manuel Roxas St., Corner N. Aquino Avenue, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga.
5. No additional documents shall be accepted by the BAC after the deadline for the Submission of Bids.
6. Prospective bidders are reminded that CIAC is VAT exempt. Thus, the bid offer or financial proposal shall be exclusive of VAT.
7. Bidders are required to make use and submit the revised Omnibus Sworn Statement form.

CIAC reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process and to reject all bid proposals at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected or bidders.
