This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is issued to modify, amend or clarify items in the bidding documents for the Supply, Delivery, Installation and Testing of Batteries for the Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) of Auxiliary System and UPS-System 2 for Radar of Clark International Airport Corporation this shall form an integral part of the bidding documents issued for the above-mentioned project.

- I. The following were the queries raised by the prospective bidders during the Pre-Bid Conference, and the corresponding remarks or instructions made by Bids and Awards Committee members and Office of Primary Responsibility (OPR):

3.	Query from Maxx-Energie Ventures Corp  With regard to the dimensions of the batteries for the project, may we offer a different size for the batteries	Yes, as long as the batteries will fit inside the storage cabinet.
4.	Query from Maxx-Energie Ventures Corp  With regard to the terminal connectors, may we offer a different type of connector other such as L-type?	As long as it will fit with our existing batteries.
5.	Query from Wite Lite Philips.Corp.  With regard to the schedule of delivery date, may we ask for an extension of forty	Yes.

6.	Query from Aspex, Inc.  With regard to the dismantling of batteries, will this be included in this project?	Yes.
7.	Query from Maxx-Energie Ventures Corp  With regard to the capacity specification of the batteries, may we be allowed to offer a higher rating?	No, it may not be compatible to our system.
8.	Query from Maxx-Energie Ventures Corp  With regard to the ITB No. stated in the Bid Documents, may we know if this is similar to the solicitation number?	None. Just leave it blank or Not applicable.
9.	Query from Wite Lite Philips.Corp.  With regard to the Bid Security, may we know if we need to submit both Bid Securing Declaration and Bid Security?	No. the Bidder may submit either BDS or Bid Security. Just take note of the consequence of a BDS.
10	Query from Aspex, Inc.  With regard to importation of goods for this project, may we know what necessary documents we need to submit?	CIAC operates within the Clark Freeport Zone; CIAC will provide the details to the bidder for tax free importation of goods for this particular project.
11.	Query from Aspex, Inc.  With regard to the contract Agreement Form included in the Bid Documents, may we know if this will be included upon submission?	No. this is just a sample form as a guide.

1.	With regard to the Certification of harmless product from IATA organization, can we present a Certificate of Environment Management System from China?	Yes.
2.	What is the tolerance level in the measurement of Battery Dimension?	As long as it will be fit inside the existing battery cabinet.
3.	Can we use the M6 terminal instead of M5?	Yes, as long as it is compatible with the existing connectors.
4.	Are inter cell connectors included?	We will be using the existing connectors.
5.	Shall we be using the existing Inter Cell Connectors?	Yes.
6.	Is there an existing battery cabinet or battery rack?	Yes.
7.	Will there be any dismantling works?	Yes.
8.	Will there be Installation of batteries?	Yes.
9.	Is the ITB number the same as Solicitation Number?	Please leave this blank or Not Applicable.
10.	Which form do we use? For Goods offered from Abroad or Goods offered within the Philippines?	Use Forms "For Goods offered from Abroad"
11.	In the form, For Goods offered from Aboard, do we fill up Columns 5, 6, 7?	Yes. Fill up all columns.
12.	Is the Contract Agreement Form included in the Submittals?	No.
13.	Can the delivery period be extended from thirty (30) to seventy five (75) days?	CIAC shall grant an extension of fifty 50 calendar days only for the delivery date of this project.
14.	If we are allowed to use the M6 Terminal, how do we fill up the Terminal Part of the Technical Specification and Statement of Compliance?	Put a remarks stating that it was issued on the bid bulletin.


15.	What form do we use for the Single Largest Contract?	Same sample forms provided in the Bid Documents.
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III. Additional reminders and clarifications to all prospective bidders:

1. The bidding process involves non-discretionary pass/fail criteria, whereby, if a Bidder submits the required document, it shall be rated "pass" for that particular requirement. In this regard, Bids that fail to include any requirement or are incomplete or patently insufficient shall be considered or rated "fail".
2. The original and copies of the bids shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed on each pages by the bidder or its duly authorized representative/s.
3. The deadline for the Submission of Bids is on November 21, 2014 (Friday) not later than 2:00 PM Philippine Standard Time (PST) at the Records Management Office (RMO) CIAC Corporate Office Building, Clark Civil Aviation Complex, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga. Late bids shall not be accepted.
4. The Opening of Bids shall be conducted on the same day, at 2:15 PM CIAC Board Room, Corporate Office Building, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga.
5. No additional documents shall be accepted by the BAC after the deadline for the Submission of Bids.
6. Only those who have Letter of Authorization from their companies stating that they are the authorized representative shall be allowed to participate. The letter of authorization shall be submitted upon submission of their bids.
7. Prospective bidders are reminded that CIAC is VAT exempt. Thus, the bid offer or financial proposal shall be exclusive of VAT.
8. Bidders are required to make use and submit the revised Omnibus Sworn Statement form.

CIAC reserves the right to accept or reject any bids to annul the bidding process and to reject all bid proposals at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected or bidders.
