



SUPPLEMENTAL BID BULLETIN NO.1

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is issued to modify, amend or clarify items in the Bidding Documents for the project Supply and Installation of Existing Conventional Lightings into Equivalent Light Emitting Diode (LED)-Lightings at the Passenger Terminal Building. This shall form an integral part of the bidding documents for the above-mentioned project.

- I. Below are the queries raised by the prospective bidders during the Pre-Bid Conference held on October 20, 2016 at the CIAC Board Room, as well as the corresponding remarks or instructions made by the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) members.

Item	Queries/Clarification	Remarks
1.	Query from Siteco. With regard to the importation of the LED equipment, may we know if we can use CIAC as the consignee of the goods?	Yes.
2.	Query from Siteco. With regard to the delivery date of thirty (30) days indicated in the Bid Documents, may we request for an extension of forty five (45) days?	All works must be completed within <u>sixty (60) working days</u> after the issuance of a Notice to Proceed to the winning bidder.
3.	Clarification from Traffic Supplies & Constructions Corp. With regard to the current electrical output for the said project, may we know if the range of the current electrical output is between 110 volts to 270 volts?	The present system voltage for this project ranges from 220 volts to 230 volts.
4.	Clarification from Traffic Supplies & Constructions Corp. With regard to the Lumens output specification of the LED lamps, may we offer the same Lumens output specification of the LED lamps with lower power wattage consumption?	Yes.

5.	<p>Query from Premier Power Lite</p> <p>With regard to the range of the CCT: 3000 K to 4000k or Color Temperature specification, may we suggest to narrow the range of CCT?</p>	<p>Suggestion in narrowing the CCT range specification will be accepted, as long as the CCT output is warm white. (Warm white CCT ranges from 3000k to 4000K).</p> <p>Narrowing the range into 3000K to 3500K is possible to achieve the required warm white output.</p>
6.	<p>Clarification from Onlite.</p> <p>With regard to the Warranty and Retention? May we know if we could use the Surety Bond to as replacement for the Retention?</p>	<p>Please refer to Section 62.1 (Warranty) of the Revised IRR of R.A. 9184 which states that, "The obligation for the warranty shall be covered by either retention money in an amount equivalent to at least ten percent (10%) of every progress payment, or a special bank guarantee equivalent to at least ten percent (10%) of the total contract price." As such, the surety bond cannot be considered as an acceptable form of warranty security.</p>
7.	<p>Query from Traffic Supplies & Constructions Corp.</p> <p>With regard to the delivery date of thirty (30) days indicated in the Bid Documents, may we request for an extension of sixty (60) days?</p>	<p>Please refer to Item.2</p>
8.	<p>Query from Traffic Supplies & Constructions Corp.</p> <p>With regard to the site inspection, may we know if we can conduct a site inspection for the project?</p>	<p>Site inspection for the project can be conducted in coordination with the BAC and/or Engineering and Maintenance Department (EMD).</p>

9.	<p>Clarification from Instrumentation & Control Specialist Inc.</p> <p>With regard to the existing power cable, may we know if we would need to replace the existing power cable for the LED lighting fixture?</p>	<p>Replacement of existing power cable for the project is not included in the scope of works.</p>

<p>Section VII. Technical Specification V. Contract /Project Duration page 67</p>	<p>The project shall cover Supply and Installation/ Replacement of Existing Conventional Lighting into Equivalent Light Emitting Diode (LED) - Lightings at the Passenger Terminal Building Street and Parking Lot premises which shall be completed within Thirty (30) Working Days after the issuance of a Notice To Proceed to the winning bidder.</p>	<p>Please refer to Item.2</p>


Additional reminders and clarifications to all prospective proponents:

1. The bidding process involves non-discretionary pass/fail criteria, whereby, if a Bidder submits the required document, it shall be rated "pass" for that particular requirement. In this regard, Bids that fail to include any requirement or are incomplete or patently insufficient shall be considered or rated "fail".
2. The original and copies of the bids shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed each pages by the bidder or its duly authorized representative/s.

3. The deadline for the Submission of Bids is on November 4, 2016 (Friday), no later than 10:00 AM Philippine Standard Time (PST) at the Records Management Office (RMO) CIAC Corporate Office Building, Clark Civil Aviation Complex, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga. Late bids shall not be accepted.
4. The Opening of Bids shall be conducted on the same day at 10:15 AM, CIAC Board Room, Corporate Office Building, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga.
5. No additional documents shall be accepted by the BAC after the deadline for the Submission of Bids.
6. Only those who have Letter of Authorization from their companies stating that they are the authorized representative shall be allowed to participate. The letter of authorization shall be submitted separately to the RMO upon submission of their bids.
7. Prospective bidders are reminded that CIAC is VAT exempt. Thus, the bid offer or financial proposal shall be exclusive of VAT.
8. Bidders are required to make use and submit the revised Omnibus Sworn Statement form.

CIAC reserves the right to accept or reject any bids to annul the bidding process and to reject all bid proposals at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected or bidders.
