This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is issued to modify, amend or clarify items in the bidding documents for the Supply, Delivery, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of IP CCTV for Passenger Terminal Building of Clark International Airport Corporation this shall form an integral part of the bidding documents issued for the above-mentioned project.

- I. The following were the queries raised by the prospective bidders during the Pre-Bid Conference, and the corresponding remarks or instructions made by Bids and Awards Committee members and Office of Primary Responsibility (OPR):

Item	Queries	Remarks/Instruction
1.	Query from Palmer-Asia With regard to the number of units of CCTV cameras to be replaced, may we know how many units will be replace and added to the project.	19 units of IP fixed CCTV camera and 5 units of IP-PTZ camera will be replaced from the existing system and 18 additional IP CCTV camera units will be added to the system. The scope of the project consists of replacement and installation of CCTV camera units.
2.	Query from Palmer-Asia With regard to make and model of the CCTV cameras, may we know if there is a preferred brand and model for this project?	As long as the CCTV units meet the minimum technical specification stated in the Bid Documents and is compatible with our existing system.
3.	Query from Palmer-Asia With regard to the Network Video Recorder (NVR) system, may we know if all CCTV camera units are operational?	Yes.
4.	Query from Palmer-Asia With regard to the Network Video Recorder (NVR) system, may we know the minimum storage capacity?	The specification for the storage capacity for the NVR system should be a minimum of one (1) month.
5.	Request from Palmer-Asia With regard to the floor plan and	Yes.

	Passenger Terminal Building, may we request for a copy?

IV. Additional reminders and clarifications to all prospective bidders:

1. The bidding process involves non-discretionary pass/fail criteria, whereby, if a Bidder submits the required document, it shall be rated "pass" for that particular requirement. In this regard, Bids that fail to include any requirement or are incomplete or patently insufficient shall be considered or rated "fail".
2. The original and copies of the bids shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed on each pages by the bidder or its duly authorized representative/s.
3. The deadline for the Submission of Bids is on November 20, 2014 (Thursday) not later than 9:00 AM Philippine Standard Time (PST) at the Records Management Office (RMO) CIAC Corporate Office Building, Clark Civil Aviation Complex, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga. Late bids shall not be accepted.
4. The Opening of Bids shall be conducted on the same day, at 9:15 AM, CIAC Board Room, Corporate Office Building, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga.
5. No additional documents shall be accepted by the BAC after the deadline for the Submission of Bids. X

6. Only those who have Letter of Authorization from their companies stating that they are the authorized representative shall be allowed to participate. The letter of authorization shall be submitted upon submission of their bids.
7. Prospective bidders are reminded that CIAC is VAT exempt. Thus, the bid offer or financial proposal shall be exclusive of VAT.
8. Bidders are required to make use and submit the revised Omnibus Sworn Statement form.

CIAC reserves the right to accept or reject any bids to annul the bidding process and to reject all bid proposals at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected or bidders.
