

## Invitation to Bid

### Design and Build of the New Eighteen-Storey Clark Air Traffic Control Tower Building Facility at Clark International Airport

1. The Bases Conversion and Development Authority (BCDA), through the General Appropriations Act (GAA) of 2020, to be undertaken by Clark International Airport Corporation (CIAC) - Special Bids and Awards Committee (SBAC), intends to apply the sum of **Two Hundred Ninety One Million Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Four Pesos and 49/100 (PHP291,009,954.49)** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the Design and Build of the New Eighteen-Storey Clark Air Traffic Control Tower Building Facility at Clark International Airport. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

The CIAC now invites bids for the Design and Build of the New Eighteen-Storey Clark Air Traffic Control Tower Building Facility at Clark International Airport. Completion of the Works is required Four Hundred Twenty (420) Calendar Days. Bidders should have completed a similar project with a contract amount equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC. For this purpose, similar contracts shall refer solely to completed design and construction of a high-rise building not less than sixteen (16) storeys. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders. Interested bidders must have at least a license category "A" and a license classification "Medium B" from the Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board (PCAB) for General Engineering. The PCAB license must be valid and effective at the time of submission of the bid.

In the event that the design and construction shall be accomplished separately by the parties in a JVA, sub-contracting or partnerships, as the case may be, the party that will accomplish the design should have at least one similar project, the cost of which is equivalent to at least 50% of the 3% of the ABC, while the party tasked to accomplish the construction component, should have at least one similar project, the cost of which is equivalent to at least 50% of the 97% of the ABC.

2. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act."

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, cooperatives, and partnerships, corporations or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.

4. Interested bidders may obtain further information from CIAC-SBAC and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from Monday to Thursday, at 8:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.
5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested bidders on **22 July 2020** from the address below and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of **Fifty Thousand Pesos (PHP50,000.00)**.

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It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System ([www.philgeps.gov.ph](http://www.philgeps.gov.ph)) and the website of CIAC ([www.ciac.ph](http://www.ciac.ph)), provided that bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

6. The CIAC-SBAC will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on **30 July 2020 (Thursday), 9:00 a.m. at CIAC Board Room, Corporate Office Building, Civil Aviation Complex, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga, Philippines 2023**, which shall be open to prospective bidders.

In order to comply with the directive to adopt social/physical distancing measures, the CIAC-SBAC shall also conduct the Pre-bid Conference thru video conferencing or teleconferencing pursuant to Section 22.3 of the Revised IRR of RA No. 9184. Prospective bidders who are interested to participate in the Pre-bid Conference shall inform the CIAC-SBAC and coordinate with the BAC Secretariat through the email address provided below.

All correspondence to and from the CIAC-SBAC shall be coursed through the email address provided below.

7. Bids must be duly received at the Records Management Office, CIAC Corporate Office Building, Civil Aviation Complex, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga, Philippines 2023 **on or before 12 August 2020 (Wednesday), 9:00 a.m.** All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 18.
8. Bid opening shall be on **12 August 2020 (Wednesday), 9:15 a.m. at the CIAC Board Room, Corporate Office Building, Civil Aviation Complex, Clark Freeport Zone, Philippines 2023.** Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below. Late bids shall not be accepted.
9. The CIAC reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
