



## SUPPLEMENTAL \ BID BULLETIN NO.1

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is issued to modify, amend or clarify items in the Bidding Documents for the project: Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of an Integrated Bird Deterrent and Monitoring System (IBDMS) for CIAC (Re-Bid) held on May 12, 2017. This shall form an integral part of the bidding documents for the above-mentioned project.

The following were the queries raised by the prospective bidders during the Pre-Bid Conference, as well as the corresponding remarks or instructions made by the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) members and Office of Prime Responsibility (OPR):

1.	<p>Clarifications from Maximum Solutions:</p> <p>With regard to <i>Section VII. Technical Specifications</i> of the Bidding Documents, under <u>Laser</u>, Item no. 14.1 and Item no. 14.3 on page 80, may we seek clarifications on the number of autonomous handheld laser sets to be supplied for this project, Which item no. will we follow?</p>	<p>Section 14.1 should be read as: "LASER            This method of bird repelling shall consist of two (2) sets of handheld unit and two (2) complete sets of Autonomous laser with software configuration management and control center."</p>
2.	<p>Queries from Maximum Solutions:</p> <p>With regard to Item no. 23. 0 on page 84 under <i>Section VII. Technical Specifications</i> of the Bidding Documents, may we know if we can supply a stand alone electronic controlled propane gas cannon instead of the central electronically controlled gas cannon as specified in the bidding documents?</p>	<p>The Pyrotechnic is part of the Integrated Bird Deterrent System and not a stand alone system. Please refer to item no. 17.0 to 17.12 of Section VII. Technical Specifications.</p>
3.	<p>Query from Maximum Solutions:</p> <p>With regard to the Remote Controlled Management System (RCMS) stated on page 97 under <i>Section VII. Technical Specifications</i> of the Bidding Documents, may we offer CIAC an open system for the RCMS to integrate the whole system?</p>	<p>Yes, an open system for the integration of the whole system may be provided by the winning bidder. An open system must comply with the requirements of the technical specifications provide in item no. 53.0 of Section VII Technical Specifications.</p>

4.	<p>Query from Maximum Solutions:</p> <p>With regards to the Network Video Recorder (NVR) specification with a capacity of 32 cameras, may we propose to supply CIAC a NVR with a capacity of 15 cameras instead of the 32 camera capacity NVR?</p>	<p>Please refer to item no. 30.2 of Section VII Technical Specifications.</p> <p>It should be read as: "32 network cameras can be connected and recorded (two (2) units sixteen (16) channel NVR)."</p>
5.	<p>Query from Maximum Solutions:</p> <p>With regard to the number of remote controlled drones to be supplied, may we know if CIAC will need the two (2) drones for this project?</p>	<p>Please refer to item 13.12 of Section VII- Technical Specifications.</p>
6.	<p>Query from Maximum Solutions:</p> <p>With regard to the site visit, may we request for a site visit?</p>	<p>Yes, please provide name of personnel in advance for the application and issuance of access pass.</p>
7.	<p>Clarification from Maximum Solutions:</p> <p>With regards to the Approved Budget of the Contract (ABC), may we seek clarification if CIAC is will still impose duties and Value Added Tax (VAT) on the ABC for this project?</p>	<p>The bid price should be exclusive of VAT.</p>

Additional reminders and clarifications to all prospective proponents:

1. The bidding process involves non-discretionary pass/fail criteria, whereby, if a Bidder submits the required document, it shall be rated "passed" for that particular requirement. In this regard, Bids that fail to include any requirement or are incomplete or patently insufficient shall be considered or rated "failed";
2. The original and copies of the bids shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed on each page by the bidder or its duly authorized representative/s;
3. The deadline for the Submission of Bids is on **May 25, 2017 (Thursday)**, no later than **1:00 PM** Philippine Standard Time (PST) at the Records Management Office (RMO) CIAC Corporate Office Building, Clark Civil Aviation Complex, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga. Late bids shall not be accepted;

4. The Opening of Bids shall be conducted on the **same day at 1:15 PM**, CIAC Board Room, Corporate Office Building, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga;
4. No additional documents shall be accepted by the BAC after the deadline for the Submission of Bids;
5. Prospective bidders are reminded that CIAC is VAT exempt. Thus, the bid offer or financial proposal shall be exclusive of VAT;
7. Bidders are required to make use and submit the revised Omnibus Sworn Statement form.

CIAC reserves the right to accept or reject any bids to annul the bidding process and to reject all bid proposals at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected or bidders.
