



SUPPLEMENTAL \ BID BULLETIN NO.1

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is issued to modify, amend or clarify items in the Bidding Documents for the project: Supply and Delivery of Ten (10) Units Mobile Lighting Tower with Generator Sets. This shall form an integral part of the bidding documents for the above-mentioned project.

The following were the queries raised by the prospective bidders during the Pre-Bid Conference held on March 31, 2017 at the CIAC Board Room, as well as the corresponding remarks or instructions made by the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) members and Office of Prime Responsibility (OPR):

Item	Queries \ Clarifications	Remarks/Instructions
1.	<p>Query from Multico</p> <p>Do you have any preference for the country where the tower light was manufactured, say made in China or made in Japan?</p>	<p>None, as long as it will comply with the specification.</p>
2.	<p>Query from Multico</p> <p>For the fuel tank capacity, 45 liters, is it the minimum? It's quite big the tank, Can we supply a little lower than 45 liters, I believe ours is eight (8) hours operations continuous. That will be ten (10) hours maximum.</p> <p>About the fuel tank capacity, in your specification it states that forty five (45) liters, can we supply lower than that, ours can serve a maximum of ten (10) hours, minimum of eight (8) hours continuous operation.</p> <p>So the important thing is the twelve (12) hours. We can supply any size of fuel tank capacity as long as it can operate minimum twelve (12) hours</p>	<p>Please refer to the Technical Specification.</p>
3.	<p>Query from Superserve Corporation</p> <p>With regard to the eligibility requirement on a similar completed project, will CIAC consider the supply of generator sets only?</p>	<p>No, what is required on this project is Mobile Lighting Power with generator which is just an accessory. The generator is required just to have a independent source of power in case of electricity gap during operation.</p>

		Similar completed project refers to the supply of mobile lighting towers with generator sets.
4.	<p>It is indicated in page 39 of the bid documents that CIAC will assist or give assistance to the bidder to avail exemptions on customs duties and taxes by designating itself as consignee.</p> <p>With regard to the dimension, I think it should depend on the manufacturer. What important is should be the height of the tower and lights.</p>	<p>Yes, CIAC shall assist the winning bidder in availing exemptions from customs duties and taxes.</p> <p>Please refer to the Technical Specifications.</p>
5.	<p>Query from Maximum Solutions</p> <p>With regard to the specifications for the generator sets as stated in page 69 which requires an upward opening for the generator enclosure to allow better access for the operators, If ever the doors will open sideways, will this be considered compliant with the requirement?</p> <p>With regard to the opening of maintenance door generator enclosure, the doors opening upward allowing operators to better access, one of the supply namin if ever the doors open sideward, so will there be a bearing na if we actually supply that kind of generators as part of the requirements.</p>	<p>The top-lift cover is to ensure maximum access for maintenance services without obstructing the left and right arm movement. It is also purposely designed as a weather canopy in case of maintenance services during rainy season. Hence, CIAC retains this specification.</p>

II. Additional reminders and clarifications to all prospective proponents:

1. The bidding process involves non-discretionary pass/fail criteria, whereby, if a Bidder submits the required document, it shall be rated "passed" for that particular requirement. In this regard, bids that fail to include any requirement or are incomplete or patently insufficient shall be considered or rated "failed".
2. The original and copies of the bids shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed each pages by the bidder or its duly authorized representative/s.
3. The deadline for the Submission of Bids is on **April 12, 2017 (Wednesday)**, no later than **2:15 PM** Philippine Standard Time (PST) at the Meeting Room D, Royce Hotel and Casino, Manuel Roxas St., Corner N. Aquino Avenue, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga Late bids shall not be accepted.
4. The Opening of Bids shall be conducted on the same day at **2:30 PM**, Meeting Room D, Royce Hotel and Casino, Manuel Roxas St., Corner N. Aquino Avenue, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga



5. No additional documents shall be accepted by the BAC after the deadline for the Submission of Bids.
6. Prospective bidders are reminded that CIAC is VAT exempt. Thus, the bid offer or financial proposal shall be exclusive of VAT.
7. Bidders are required to make use and submit the revised Omnibus Sworn Statement form.

CIAC reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process and to reject all bid proposals at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected or bidders.
