





SUPPLEMENTAL \ BID BULLETIN NO.1

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is issued to modify, amend or clarify items in the Bidding Documents for the project: Supply and Delivery of Four (4) units of motorized passenger stairs for CIAC. This shall form an integral part of the bidding documents for the above-mentioned project.

The following were the queries raised by the prospective bidders during the Pre-Bid Conference held on 31 March 2017 at the CIAC Board Room, as well as the corresponding remarks or instructions made by the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) members and Office of Prime Responsibility (OPR):

Item	Queries \ Clarifications	Remarks / Instructions
1.	<p>Request raised by Microtronix Marketing Sales and Service Center/Jiangsu Tianyi Airport Special Equipment Co. Ltd.</p> <p>We plan to enter into a joint venture agreement with a foreign company who is into this kind of business which is selling motorized passenger stairs. As stated in the bidding documents, one of the requirements for eligibility, in case of a joint venture, is that the bidder must be at least sixty percent (60%) Filipino owned. My worry is that since we are new in this kind of business we might not be able to comply with the technical eligibility documents required.</p>	<p>Pursuant to the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9184, "Persons / entities forming themselves into a joint venture, i.e., a group of two (2) or more persons/entities that intend to be jointly and severally responsible or liable for a particular contract: Provided, however, That Filipino ownership or interest of the joint venture concerned shall be at least sixty percent (60%)" shall be eligible to participate in the bidding.</p> <p>In addition, each partner of the joint venture shall submit their respective PhilGEPS Certificates of Registration in accordance with Section 8.5.2 of the IRR. The submission of technical and financial eligibility documents by any of the joint venture partners constitutes compliance: Provided, that the partner responsible to submit the NFCC shall likewise submit the Statement of all of its ongoing contracts and Audited Financial Statements.</p>

2.	<p>Request raised by Microtronix Marketing Sales and Service Center/Jiangsu Tianyi Airport Special Equipment Co. Ltd.</p> <p>Regarding page 68, item B Stairs of the Technical Specifications, it is indicated here that the minimum platform height is 2200mm, as per discussion with our partner/supplier the minimum height is 2400mm, there is approximately eight inches difference. Will this be accepted?</p>	<p>The 2400mm to be offered shall be accepted even if the requirement indicated in the technical specifications which is 2200mm is the minimum required. The aircraft type that can be served are from smallest, B-737, A-319, A-320 and A-321 to largest B-777 and B-787.</p>
3.	<p>Request raised by Microtronix Marketing Sales and Service Center/Jiangsu Tianyi Airport Special Equipment Co. Ltd.:</p> <p>Regarding mode of payment, per experience with other bidding there is a fifteen percent down payment. May we be clarified on this?</p>	<p>Advance payment is not allowed.</p>
4.	<p>Request raised by Microtronix Marketing Sales and Service Center/Jiangsu Tianyi Airport Special Equipment Co. Ltd.</p> <p>On page 69, item 6 of the technical specifications under II Terms and Conditions, it is stated that "The prospective bidder must have a showroom, warehouse or factory to handle after sales service for repairs of defects found during the warranty period." Will it matter if the office is not located in Luzon?</p>	<p>It does not matter if your showroom, warehouse or factory is not located in Luzon.</p>

II. Additional reminders and clarifications to all prospective proponents:

1. The bidding process involves non-discretionary pass/fail criteria, whereby, if a Bidder submits the required document, it shall be rated "passed" for that particular requirement. In this regard, bids that fail to include any requirement or are incomplete or patently insufficient shall be considered or rated "failed".
2. The original and copies of the bids shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed each pages by the bidder or its duly authorized representative/s.
3. The deadline for the Submission of Bids is on **April 12, 2017 (Wednesday)**, no later than **4:00 PM** Philippine Standard Time (PST) at the Meeting Room D, Royce Hotel and Casino, Manuel Roxas St., Corner N. Aquino Avenue, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga. Late bids shall not be accepted.

4. The Opening of Bids shall be conducted on the same day at **4:15 PM**, Meeting Room D, Royce Hotel and Casino, Manuel Roxas St., Corner N. Aquino Avenue, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga.
5. No additional documents shall be accepted by the BAC after the deadline for the Submission of Bids.
6. Prospective bidders are reminded that CIAC is VAT exempt. Thus, the bid offer or financial proposal shall be exclusive of VAT.
7. Bidders are required to make use and submit the revised Omnibus Sworn Statement form.

CIAC reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process and to reject all bid proposals at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected or bidders.
