



SUPPLEMENTAL \ BID BULLETIN NO.1


This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is issued to modify, amend or clarify items in the Bidding Documents for the project: Re-painting of Runway and Taxiway Pavement Marking at the Clark International Airport (CRK). This shall form an integral part of the bidding documents for the above-mentioned project.

The following were the queries raised by the prospective bidders during the Pre-Bid Conference held on March 31, 2017 at the CIAC Board Room, as well as the corresponding remarks or instructions made by the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) members and Office of Prime Responsibility (OPR):

Item	Queries \ Clarifications	Remarks / Instructions
1.	<p>Query from MSV Construction:</p> <p>On page 64, under Reflective Media, it is stated that the glass beads shall meet the minimum requirements of the following specifications: DPWH, JIS, AASHTO. May we be clarified if the requirement is any of the three specifications and not all specifications?</p>	<p>It is stated in the technical specifications, glass beads shall meet the minimum requirements of any of the following specifications: DPWH, JIS, AASHTO.</p>
2.	<p>Query from Traffic Supplies Construction Corporation (TSCC):</p> <p>Regarding material testing, what are we going to attach on our bids? Will it be the previous material testing results?</p>	<p>The material testing results are not required to be submitted during the date for the submission of bids.</p> <p>However, please take note that under Clause 16.1 of the Special Conditions of the Contract, the required inspections and tests that will be conducted on the thermoplastic paint to be applied shall be the Quality Test for DPWH standard item 612. Before the application of the thermoplastic paint, material testing shall be conducted. Hence, the material testing shall be conducted during contract implementation.</p>

5.	<p>Query from Subiccon Corporation:</p> <p>Do we require a consultant on the thermoplastic and asphalt overlay?</p>	No.
	<p>Query from MSV Construction:</p> <p>On page 65, item 5 under Equipment, are we required to submit proof of ownership? In case, the equipment is not owned but leased, may we submit lease agreement/s? Is a purchase agreement acceptable?</p>	<p>Yes, proof of ownership for the required equipment such as Official Receipt/s and Certificate/s of Registration (in case the equipment is owned) and lease agreement/s shall be required. Purchase agreement shall not be accepted.</p>
	<p>Query from MSV Construction:</p> <p>Will we be allowed to put a temporary facility for the project duration</p> <p>For other projects, we usually put a container van, which will serve as our temporary office so that it will be more convenient to conduct technical, field and coordination meetings with our workers and staff involved for this project.</p>	<p>Yes. The contractor is allowed to put up a temporary facility (container van) for the whole project duration as temporary office only.</p>

II. Additional reminders and clarifications to all prospective proponents:

1. The bidding process involves non-discretionary pass/fail criteria, whereby, if a Bidder submits the required document, it shall be rated "passed" for that particular requirement. In this regard, bids that fail to include any requirement or are incomplete or patently insufficient shall be considered or rated "failed".
2. The original and copies of the bids shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed each pages by the bidder or its duly authorized representative/s.
3. The deadline for the Submission of Bids is on **April 3, 2017 (Monday)**, no later than **9:45 AM** Philippine Standard Time (PST) at the Meeting Room D, Royce Hotel and Casino, Manuel Roxas St., Corner N. Aquino Avenue, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga. Late bids shall not be accepted.
4. The Opening of Bids shall be conducted on the same day at **10:00 AM**, Meeting Room D, Royce Hotel and Casino, Manuel Roxas St., Corner N. Aquino Avenue, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga.
5. No additional documents shall be accepted by the BAC after the deadline for the Submission of Bids.
6. Prospective bidders are reminded that CIAC is VAT exempt. Thus, the bid offer or financial proposal shall be exclusive of VAT. 

7. Bidders are required to make use and submit the revised Omnibus Sworn Statement form.

CIAC reserves the right to accept or reject any bids to annul the bidding process and to reject all bid proposals at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected or bidders.
