



SUPPLEMENTAL/BID BULLETIN NO.2

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is issued to modify, amend or clarify items in the Bidding Documents for the project: **"Provision of Petroleum for Clark International Airport Corporation for CY 2023"**. This shall form an integral part of the bidding documents for the above-mentioned project.

- I. Below were the queries and/or requests for clarification from PETRON CORPORATION during the Pre-bid Conference of the said project held on 07 December 2022 and conducted thru video conferencing via Zoom Application, as well as the corresponding remarks or instructions made by the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) members and Office of Prime Responsibility (OPR):

1	How would we be able to modify the Terms of Reference because we do not deliver fuel to our clients. Fleet cards are used to avail gasoline/diesel.	There is no need to change or modify the technical specifications of the bidding documents. If you cannot comply with the requirements of Lot 2: Diesel for Generator sets, you may join only in Lot 1: Diesel and Gasoline for various vehicles.

- II. Below were the queries and/or requests for clarification from PETRON CORPORATION received through electronic mail on 09 December 2022, as well as the corresponding remarks or instructions made by the BAC members and OPR:

No.	Queries/Clarifications	Remarks from the BAC and OPR
1	Request for Extension for the Submission of Bid. We request for your kind consideration to extend the submission of bid from December 19, 2022 to December 28, 2022 to ensure full preparation of bid documents with respective signatories.	The date of submission and opening of bids shall proceed as scheduled on December 19, 2022 at 3:00pm and 3:15pm, respectively.
2	Request for the Issuance of Notice of Extension (NOE) to ensure continuous fleet services. As the year 2022 is nearing its end, we highly suggest for the issuance of a NOE in favor of Petron Corporation for the 2022 Petron Fleet Card contract (Petron Corporation with CIAC for the provision of Petroleum) as the contract shall end on December 31, 2022.	The CIAC is constrained to grant or issue NOE since no contract extension shall exceed one (1) year in pursuant to Section 4.1 of the revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9184 (R.A. No.9184).

- III. Additional reminders and clarifications to all prospective bidders:

- The deadline for the Submission of Bids is on **December 19, 2022 (Monday)**. Bids must be duly received by the CIAC Records Management Office located in the CIAC Corporate Office Building **not later than 3:00 p.m.** Late bids shall not be accepted.

2. The Opening of Bids shall be conducted at **3:15 p.m. of December 19, 2022 (Monday)** at the CIAC Board Room, Corporate Office Building, Civil Aviation Complex, Clark Freeport Zone and thru video conferencing using Zoom Application. Only one (1) representative for each bidder shall be allowed to attend the opening of bids physically onsite. Provided, that said representative shall present a Negative Antigen Test Result taken within 24 hours from the date of the Opening of Bids and shall be required to wear a face mask while within the Corporate Office Building. For bidders who shall attend the opening of bids thru video conferencing, they are advised to indicate their Company Name and Full Name as their username for proper identification.
3. Bidders are required to submit one (1) original and two (2) copies of the first and second components of its bid which shall be signed or initialed on each and every page thereof by the duly authorized representative/s of the Bidder.
4. Prospective bidders are reminded that a suspended or blacklisted supplier, contractor or consultant shall not be allowed to participate in all procurement opportunities of the government for the duration of the suspension or blacklisting, regardless of the modality of procurement employed by the procuring entity.
5. Bid envelopes that are not properly sealed and marked shall be accepted provided that the bidder or its duly authorized representative shall acknowledge such condition of the bid as submitted. The BAC shall assume **no responsibility** for the misplacement of the contents of the improperly sealed or unmarked bid, or for its premature opening.
6. Should a bidder decide **not to submit** a bid, said bidder should justify in writing to the BAC the reason for the non-submission. This provision is applicable to companies who have purchased the bidding documents for the said project. Pursuant to Section 69.1 of the Revised of IRR of RA No. 9184, sanctions shall be imposed to the bidder who habitually withdraws from bidding, submits late bids or patently insufficient bids for at least three (3) times within a year, except for a valid reason.
7. Note: Caution to prospective bidders, should there be individuals posing in behalf of the CIAC-BAC and TWG as agents or fixers, the same should be reported to the CIAC-BAC immediately. This shall not be tolerated by the CIAC-BAC. The bidding shall be conducted impartially and fairly and no favoritism shall be extended to any prospective bidder or bidder. For as long as the same submits complete requirements, the said bidder shall be qualified.

The CIAC reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
